If there is a need to continue the process of simplifying licensing procedures for economic activities, under paragraph f) of paragraph 1 of article 204 of the Constitution of the Republic, the Council of Ministers decrees:

Article 1. The Simplified Legal Regime for Licensing for the Exercise of Economic Activities is approved, which comprises the Simplified License and the Certificate of Mere Prior Communication, attached, which is an integral part of this

Art. 2. Decree No. 5/2012, of March 7, which approves the Simplified Licensing Regulation, paragraph 1 of article 25 of the Industrial Activity Licensing Regulation approved by Decree No. 22, are revoked. /2014, of 16 May and other legal provisions that contradict the provisions of this Decree.

Art. 3. The Minister who oversees the area of Industry and Commerce is responsible for approving and updating instruments

and forms referring to the Simplified Legal Regime for Licensing for the Exercise of Economic Activities.

Art. 4. This Decree comes into force on the date of its publication.

Simplified Legal Regime for Licensing to Exercise of Economic Activities

CHAPTER I

General Provisions

AARTICLE 1

(Definitions)

The meaning of the terms used is set out in the attached glossary, which is an integral part of this Legal Framework.

Aarticletwo

(Object)

- 1. This Simplified Licensing Legal Regime for the Exercise of Economic Activities aims to establish the simplified license regime and the certificate of mere prior communication of economic activities that, by their nature, do not cause negative impacts on the environment, public health, safety and the economy in general.
- 2. Without prejudice to the provisions of the previous paragraph, this Legal Regime also includes economic activities that may cause negligible, insignificant or minimal negative impacts included in Category C of Environmental Impact Assessment.

AARTICLE3

(Scope)

This Legal Regime applies to natural or legal persons who wish to carry out economic activity in the national territory.

AARTICLE4

(Competence)

1. The Single Service Counters are responsible for processing and issuance of simplified licenses and certificates of mere prior communication, as well as suspension and revocation.

- 2. In places where there are no Service Desks Solely, the District Governments are competent to process and issue the simplified license.
- 3. For the purposes of the provisions of the previous paragraph, the Governments Districts must coordinate with the Single Service Counters to ensure compliance with procedures related to simplified licensing.

AARTICLE 5

(Register)

- 1. The entities referred to in the previous article must create, manage and keep the registration of the Simplified Licensing Legal Regime updated.
- 2. Registration information carried out by Governments District payments must be sent monthly to the Single Service Desk, following the model set out in Annex 1 of this Regime.
- 3. The entities competent to issue the license simplified form and the certificate of mere prior communication, they must send the respective information to specific entities and also to the following entities:
 - *The*) National Inspection of Economic Activities; *B*) Migration Services, when dealing with foreign citizens;
 - w) Local commands of the Police of the Republic of Mozambique; d) Provincial Directorates that oversee the areas of Industry and Commerce, Culture and Tourism, Labor, Transport and Communications, Agriculture and Public Works;
 - It is) National Public Safety Service.

AARTICLE 6

(Eligibility)

The request for a simplified license and mere prior communication can be submitted by a national natural or legal person and by a foreign natural person.

AARTICLE 7

(Environmental impact)

- 1. The exercise of economic activities covered by This Legal Regime is generally not subject to Environmental Impact Assessment.

CHAPTER II

Procedures for Mere Prior Communication and Obtaining a Simplified License

SECTION I

Procedures for Mere Prior Communication $A_{\text{ARTICLE}} 8$

(Process instruction)

- 1. Mere prior communication is made through presentation specific form, set out in Annex 2 of this Regime, duly completed, accompanied by one of the following documents:
 - *The*) Copy of valid Identity Card, Passport, Driving License, Professional License or Voter Card, for nationals;

- B) Identification and Residence Document for Foreigners or Passport with business visa or precarious residence permit with a minimum validity of 6 months, for foreigners.
- 2. The applicant must also attach the registration certificate of legal entity or copy of the publication of the statute of the commercial company in *Republic Bulletin* and proof of the status of the applicant, in the case of legal entities, and the Unique Tax Identification Number.
- 3. For activities whose exercise is authorized by Orders Professionals or another entity, a copy of the document issued by them must be attached to the communication.
- 4. The request and documents that guide the communication may be presented in physical or electronic format.
- 5. In the mere prior communication required for activities of real estate and the provision of cultural, accounting, management and consultancy services in the legal, architectural, engineering and related areas by natural persons, an annex to a residence is also considered to be a professional domicile.
- 6. Mere prior communication submitted by an applicant who already holds a previous simplified license for new activities, the documents provided for in paragraphs *The*) *B*) It is *w*) of paragraph 1.

AARTICLE 9

(Activities subject to mere prior communication)

The following activities are exempt from the simplified license and subject to mere prior communication:

The) Business

- n) Subclass 47610, class 4761, Group 476, Division 47, Section G of the CAE: retail trade of bookstore and stationery items, bookbinding, office items, including drawing and painting materials, school supplies, excluding furniture and machines, in non-specialized establishments;
- ii) Subclass 47630, Class 4763, Group 477, Division 47, Section G of the CAE: retail sale of sporting, camping and leisure articles in specialized establishments;
- iii) Subclass 47711, Class 4771, Group 477, Division 47, Section G of the CAE: retail trade in fabrics, fashions and clothing, articles of clothing for men, women and children, costume jewelry and similar adornments, aprons, dust cloths, crockery and socks, curtains and their accessories, in nonspecialized establishments;
- *iv*) Subclass 47712, Class 4771, Group 477, Division 47, Section G of the CAE: retail trade in shoemaking, footwear and footwear items in non-specialized establishments.

B) Services provision

- *i*) Subclass 69100, class 6910, Group 691, Division 69, Section M of the CAE: provision of legal services;
- ii) Subclass 69200, Class 6920, Group 692, Division 69, Section M of the CAE: provision of accounting and auditing services;
- *iii*) Subclass 70100, Class 7010, Group 701, Division 70, Section M of the CAE: activities of the registered offices;
- *iv*) Subclass 70200, Class 7020, Group 702, Division 70, Section M of CAE: business and management consultancy activities;
- v) Subclass 71101, Class 7110, Group 711, Division 71, Section M of CAE: provision of architectural services;

и. Subclass 71102, Class 7110, Group 711, Division 71, Section M of CAE: provision of engineering services and related techniques;

viii. Subclass 96090, Class 9609, Group 960, Division 96, CAE Section S: other personal service activities, ne; event decoration and entertainment activities, photocopying, translator and interpreter services.

AARTICLE 10

(Deadline for issuing the Certificate)

The competent entity must issue the communication certificate in person and within a maximum period of one day, following the model in Annex 3.

AARTICLE11

(Validity)

The certificate replaces the license and is valid for an indefinite period.

SECTION II

Procedures for obtaining the Simplified License

AARTICLE12

(Process instruction)

- 1. The application for a simplified license is made through presentation of the appropriate form, included in Annex 4 of this Legal Framework, duly completed, accompanied by one of the following documents:
 - *The*) Copy of valid Identity Card, Passport, Driving License, Professional License or Voter Card, for nationals;
 - B) Identification and Residence Document for Foreigners or Passport with business visa or precarious residence permit with a minimum validity of 6 months, for foreigners.
- 2. The applicant must also attach the registration certificate of legal entity or copy of the publication of the commercial company's statute in the Boletim da República and proof of the applicant's status, in the case of legal entities, the Unique Tax Identification Number and the Environmental License for category C activities.
- 3. The request and documents supporting the request of the simplified license can be presented in physical or electronic format.
- 4. When requesting a license for another activity, presented by an applicant who already holds a previous simplified license, the documents provided for in paragraphs are not required. s1 and 2 of this article.

AARTICLE13

(Activities subject to Simplified Licensing)

1. They constitute areas of economic activities subject to the simplified licensing the following:

The) Agriculture;

B) Business;

и) Communications;

d) Construction; It is)

Culture;

f) Industry;

g) Fishing;

H) Services provision; I)

Tourism.

2. The economic activities of the areas indicated in the number above, are included in the table that constitutes Annex 5 of this Legal Regime.

AARTICLE14

(License issuance period)

The competent entity must issue the simplified license in person and within a maximum period of one day, following the model in Annex 6.

AARTICLE 15

(Validity)

The simplified license is valid for an indefinite period.

AARTICLE 16

(Obligations of the Licensee)

1. The holder of the simplified license, taking into account the type of activity, you are especially obliged to:

The) Communicate the change of address;

B) Have equipment or instruments appropriate to the activity;

w) Ensure hygiene and health conditions;

 d) Comply with labeling standards and expiration dates on product packaging;

It is) Fix and display prices in national currency;

f) Post the complaints box;

- g) The minimum dimensions and areas and the minimum classification criteria for Room Rental for Tourist Purposes and Private Accommodation for Tourist Purposes.
- H) Do not use advertising phrases or designs that may deceive good faith or mislead buyers and/or consumers regarding the nature, content or quality of the product;
- i) Observe the hiring standards for national and foreign workers;
- j) Observe safety and fire regulations; k) Collaborate with all public institutions for the best performance of the activity;
- /) Comply with tax and social security obligations; m)
 Do not manufacture, manipulate, package, store or sell products and/or substances that are prohibited by law; n) Comply with specific legislation for the field of activity.
- 2. The duties of the simplified license holder apply to the holder of the certificate of mere prior communication.

CHAPTER III

Fees, inspection and penalties

SECTION I

Fees

AARTICLE 17

(Fees)

- 1. Fees are due for all acts subject to the licensing under the terms of this Legal Regime.
- 2. They constitute acts of the Simplified Legal Regime of Licensing of Economic Activities subject to payment of the following fees:

The) License request; *B*) Reissuance of the license; *w*) Endorsement.

3. Mere prior communication is not subject to any fee.

AARTICLE18

(The fee)

The value of the fee to be paid for simplified licensing acts corresponds to fifty percent of the minimum wage in force in the public service.

AARTICLE 19

(Destination of Fees)

1. The revenue resulting from the payment of the fee provided for in the This Legal Regime is distributed in accordance with the following order:

The) 60% for the State Budget; *B*) 40% to the Licensing Entity.

2. The distribution of the percentage indicated in paragraph *B*) of previous number is the responsibility of the Minister who oversees the area of Industry and Commerce.

SECTION II

Inspection and Penalties

AARTICLE 20

(Oversight)

- 1. Economic agents licensed under the terms of this regime are subject to inspection subsequent to the issuance of the license and the certificate of mere prior communication, by the competent authorities, to verify compliance with the operating conditions established in the general and specific legislation of the licensed economic activity.
- 2. Without prejudice to the provisions of special legislation, the supervisory entities referred to in the previous paragraph are, among others, within the limits of their powers:

The) National Inspection of Economic Activities; *B*) National Institute of Standardization and Quality; *w*) Mozambique Tax Authority; *d*) General Labor Inspectorate;

It is) The entities responsible for Agricultural and Veterinary Services;

f) Fisheries Administration.

AARTICLE21

(Sanction regime)

Without prejudice to the provisions of the following articles, the sanctioning regime consists of, among others, the following instruments:

The) Labor Law, Law no. 23/2017, of 1 August and its regulations;

- B) Law No. 2/2006, of March 22, Corporate Income Tax Code, Personal Income Tax Code, Value Added Tax Code, Specific Consumption Tax Code, Customs Tariff and the respective Preliminary Instructions;
- w) Metrology Legal Regime, approved by Decree-Law no. 2/2010, of 31 December;
- A) Regulation on Tourist Enterprises, Restaurants and Beverages and Dance Rooms, approved by Decree No. 49/2016, of 1 November;
- *It is*) Industrial Activity Licensing Regulation approved by Decree no. 22/2014, of 16 May;
- f) Commercial Activity Licensing Regulation approved by Decree no. 34/2013, of 2 August.

AARTICLE 22

(Suspension)

- 1. Failure to comply with obligations arising from the license simplified and mere communication, provided for in article 16 of this Regime, gives rise to the suspension of the license for a period of 15 days.
- 2. Lifting the suspension depends on compliance with the obligations indicated by supervisory entities.

AARTICLE23

(Cessation)

The following forms of termination of the simplified license and the certificate of mere prior communication:

The) Renounce;

B) Revocation.

AARTICLE24

(Renounce)

- 1. The holder of the simplified license and the certificate of mere prior communication may, in writing, waive your right to the licensing entity.
- 2. Communication of physical or electronic resignation must be accompanied by the original of the respective license and the certificate of mere prior communication.

AARTICLE 25

(Revocation)

1. The revocation of the simplified license and the certificate of mere Prior communication occurs:

The) For not carrying out the activity for six months; B) In cases of repeated non-compliance with general and specific legislation for the type of activity carried out:

- w) For the provision of false statements by the license holder to the licensing entity;
- a) Suspension, prohibition of carrying out the activity and the consequent cancellation of registration by the Professional Association:
- It is) For non-compliance with the recommendations resulting from the suspension.
- 2. The revocation of the simplified license and the certificate of mere Prior communication may occur through a complaint from any interested party or on the initiative of the licensing entity if the conditions described in the previous paragraph are met.

CHAPTER IV

Transitional provisions

AARTICLE 26

(Coexistence of legal regimes)

The provisions on the licensing of economic activities provided for in the different sectoral legislation, which are not part of Annex 5 of this Legal Framework, remain in force.

AARTICLE 27

(Deadline for license regularization)

Economic agents must regularize their licenses with the licensing entity within a year, free of charge.

Glossary

For the purposes of this Legal Regime, the following definitions apply:

- The) Economic Activity: result of the combination of productive factors, namely labor, raw materials, equipment with a view to producing goods or services;
- *B*) Single Service Desk: concentrated unit for the provision of public services;
- w) Registration of the Simplified Licensing Registry: record of data that includes, among others, name, nationality, contact, activity within the scope of the CAE, address, investment volume, number of workers and other relevant information;
- *d*) CAE: Classifier of Economic Activities of Mozambique;
- It is) Certificate of mere prior communication: document issued by the Balcão de Atendimento Único or similar entity that certifies that the communication was made;
- f) Licensing entity: the Balcão de Atendimento Único and in its absence the District Government;
- g) Specialized establishment: the object of which is the sale, predominantly, of a single family of products or a restricted number of related families; H) Nonspecialized establishment: what it means

- The object is the sale of various food and nonfood products, with no particular emphasis on any one;
- Inspection: activity carried out by the competent bodies to inspect economic activities, with a view to ensuring compliance with legislation;
- j) Simplified Licensing: processing and issuance in person or electronically of a License to carry out economic activity, as well as the act by which the entrepreneur informs the Balcão de Atendimento Único or similar entity of compliance with the legal requirements for carrying out economic activity and the location where it will take place;
- k) Simplified License: document that entitles the respective holder to carry out the economic activity requested and authorized by the competent entity;
- // Subsequent verification: act that consists of verifying compliance with general and specific legislation for the licensed activity after the license has been issued;
- m) Inspection: procedural activity carried out by the competent body, with a view to verifying compliance with the terms and conditions necessary for granting the requested license.
